- ✓ Spectators with Special Needs

THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STADIUM MANAGEMENT AND FA'S IS TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF SPECTATORS BY CONTROLLING THE SALE OF TICKETS AND DISCOURAGING SPECTATORS FROM CLIMBING ON FLOODLIGHTS. SPECTATORS.



EDUCATION IS CRITICAL TO ENLIGHTEN THE SPECTATORS. POLITICIANS WHO ALLOW FREE ENTRY OF SPECTATORS MUST BE DISCOURAGED.

THIS PICTURE ALSO SHOWS THAT THERE WAS NO CONTROL AT ALL AND THE STADIUM WAS OVERWHELMED.



THE DANGERS OF POOR SECURITY AND STADIUM CONTROL RESULTS IN SUCH INCIDENTS. CROWD VIOLENCE AND POOR INFRASTRUCTURES CAN CAUSE DEATH AND SERIOUS DESTRUCTIONS.



EQUIPMENT CAN LEAD TO DEATH AS SHOWN IN THIS PICTURE WHERE SPECTATORS OF A FOOTBALL CLUB IN KENYA CARRY THEIR INJURED COLLEAGUE DURING STADIUM STAMPEDE.
